

Introduction to Descriptive Text

- **Definition:** descriptive text is a text which says what a person or a thing is like in detail including the specific characteristics.
- **Social function:**
To describe a person, thing or place in detail.

Example:



<p>Identification</p> <p>To introduce the place (name and location)</p>	<p>Taman Mini Indonesia Indah (literally Beautiful Indonesia Miniature Park) is located in East Jakarta, Indonesia. It is a cultural recreation park. The area of the park covers about or 1km².</p>
<p>Description</p> <p>Describe the place in more detailed information</p>	<p>The park exhibits Indonesian culture from all the provinces in Indonesia. They are shown in separate pavilions, including the collection of traditional costumes, dances, and traditional customs and aspect of daily life in Indonesia.</p> <p>In the middle of the park, there is a lake with a miniature of the archipelago. We can see views of archipelago clearly from above by using cable cars.</p> <p>The Keong Mas Imax Cinema is another recreational facility in Taman Mini Indonesia Indah. It is called Keong Mas due to its unique snail-like structure. The building resembles the Opera House in Sydney, Australia, making the park one of the most popular destinations in Jakarta.</p>
