## Telling Time on the Hour



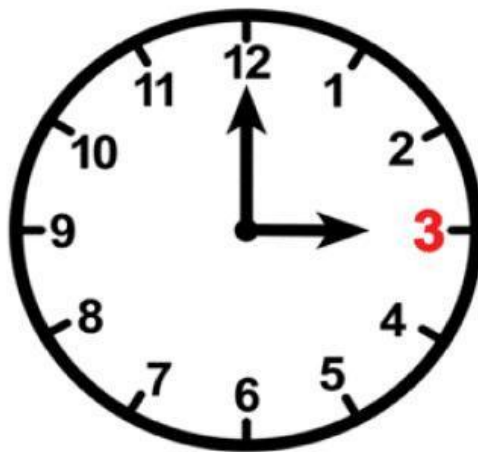
Telling time on the hour is easy!

First, look at the **short hand**: This hand tells you the **hour**. See which number it is pointing to.

Then, look at the long hand: This hand tells you the minutes. When it points to **12**, it means "**o'clock**".

Next, put it together: Say the number the **short hand** is pointing to, then say "**o'clock**".

Here is an example: If the **short hand** is pointing to **3** and the **long hand** is pointing to **12**, say "**3 o'clock**".

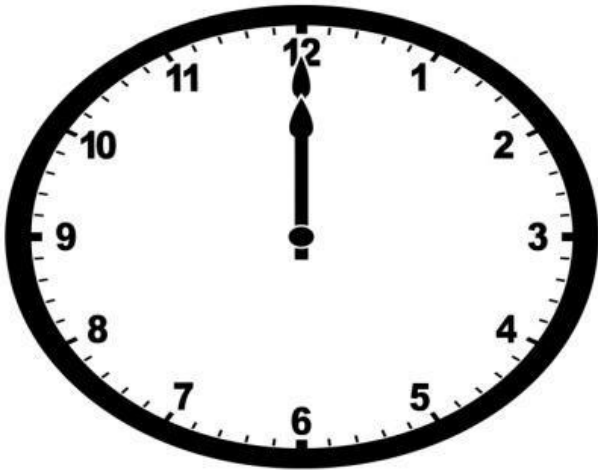
