Irregular past participles

Some irregular verbs have a past participle that is different to the past simple form. Watch out for these verbs and keep a list in your notebook.

Examples:

2	see	saw	seen
3	break	broke	broken
4	sing	sang	sung
5	speak	spoke	spoken
