1. A \_\_\_\_\_ is an area on the coast used for loading and unloading vessels. It may include one or more harbours. It includes container parks, warehouses for storage, etc.
2. A \_\_\_\_\_ is an area where vessels and boats are protected from the weather.
3. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a small port or harbour that is used for pleasure boats or yachts and NOT for cargo or passenger ships.
4. A \_\_\_\_\_ or wharf is a structure parallel the shore where ships may dock to load and unload cargo or drop off and pick up passengers.
5. A \_\_\_\_\_ or jetty is an elevated structure that extends into the water (perpendicular to the water) where vessels can dock and people can walk.
6. A \_\_\_\_\_ is any area where you can dock a ship.
7. A \_\_\_\_\_ is like the parking place for a boat or ship. In a port, they are numbered, like the parking spaces in a garage.
8. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a barrier made of rocks that protects a harbour or shore from the waves.
9. To \_\_\_\_\_ (verb) a vessel means to secure a vessel to a fixed point with the help of ropes or lines.
10. The \_\_\_\_\_ (2 words) is a machine used for moving the anchor up and down.
