Money Problems - Bills

Understand how to set down a bill and evaluate it

All of us have to pay **bills** at times. In a shop; at the supermarket; in a restaurant. Most shops and restaurants ring up the bill on their screens and print it out for you.

When setting down a bill, try to **line up the decimal points**.

Example :-

When there is a mixture like $£3.78 + 47p$, change the 47p to $£0.47$ first.
