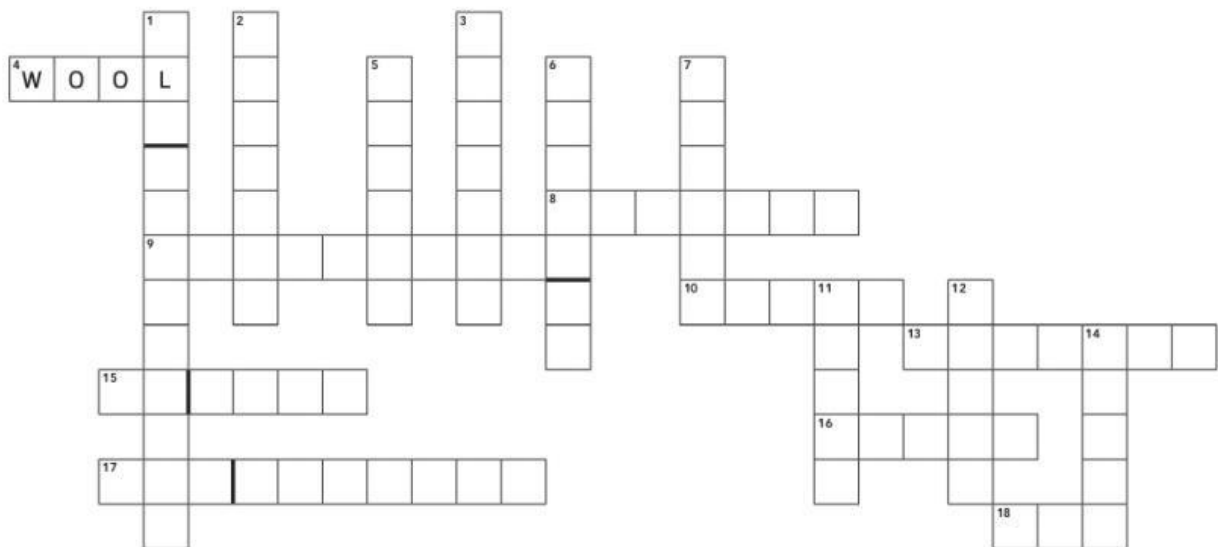


## 2B VOCABULARY Clothes and fashion
