A landform is a natural formation or area of land. There are many different types of landforms that cover the Earth. Some of huge canyons that are far away, while others can be in your backyard. Landforms can even be flat areas of land, such as wide open plains and prairies. And finally, some landforms can involve water, such as bays and oceans. Scientists called geologists study these landforms to see what caused them and how they interact with the land around them.

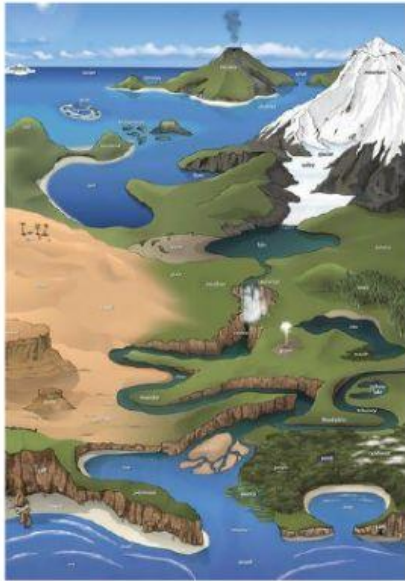

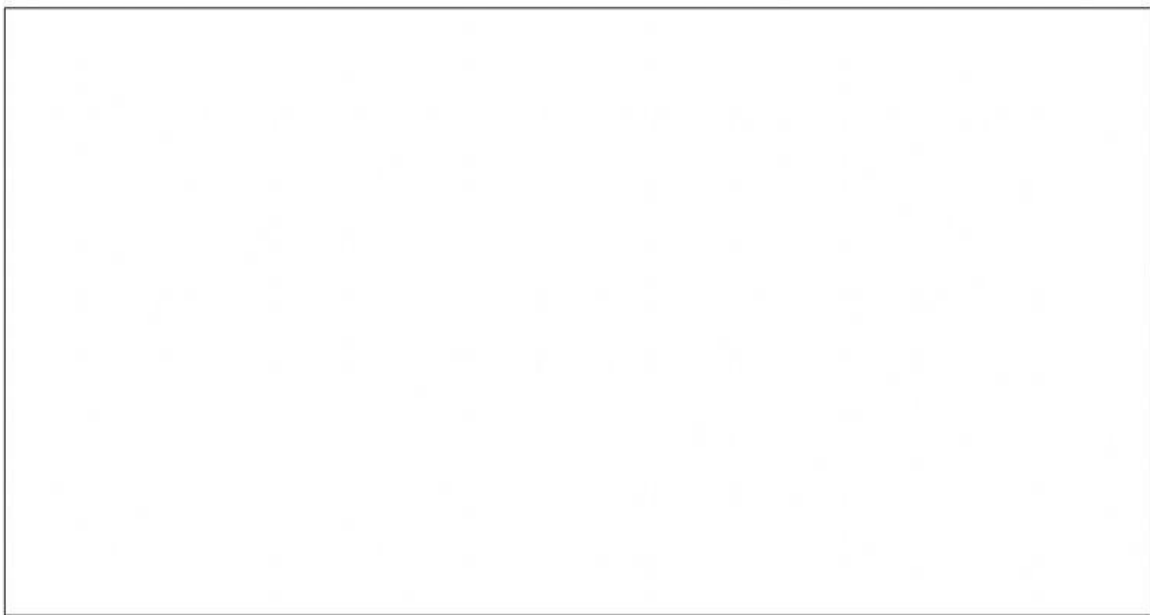

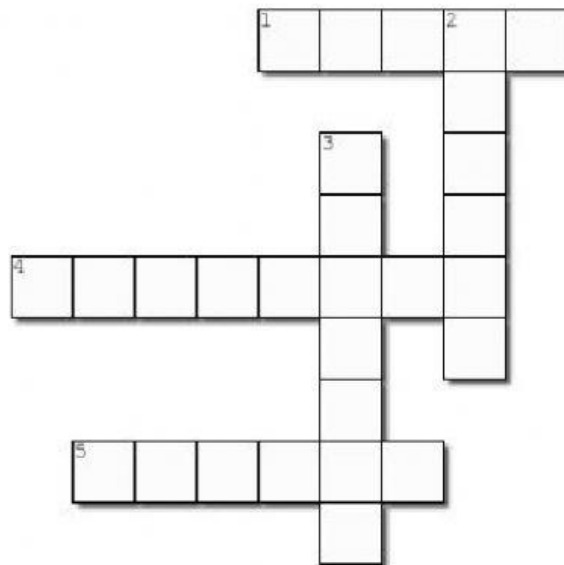
