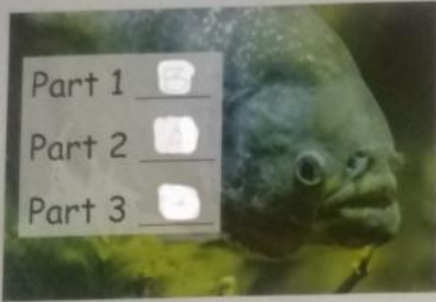

A. They are so sharp that the Amazonian Indians use them as scissors. Piranhas never stop growing, so they are always hungry.

B. Piranhas live in rivers in South America. They have small, triangular teeth.

C. They only attack when they are in danger or when their nests are threatened. Eagles have long curved claws called talons. They are ideal for picking up a small deer or a lamb.

D. They can eat a large animal in minutes! Piranhas rarely attack people, but in 1981 more than 300 passengers were killed and eaten when their boat capsized in Brazil.

E. These fleas bite humans and spread dangerous plagues. There are about 120 kinds of rats. Black rats and brown rats are the most common. Brown rats are large. They are bigger than black rats.

F. They eat almost every kind of plant and animal—including other rats. They can also cause fires by biting the insulation around electrical wires. Rats also carry fleas.

G. These birds are very strong. They can carry an animal of their own weight in their claws.

H. Rats live all over the world. Many people are scared of them. Rats spread diseases, destroy crops, and kill small animals.
