

Adverbs have different functions. They tell us when, how or where actions are performed:

Eg: Yesterday the animals had a party. (Yesterday is an adverb of time. It tells when)

Eg: They danced wildly. (Wildly is an adverb of manner. It tells us how).

Eg: A lot of animals were there. (There is an adverb of place. It tells us Where)

TYPES	ADVERBS	EXAMPLES
Adverbs of Time	Already, ago, before, yet, never, yesterday, soon, lately	I have heard this before. I have not seen him since. I haven't spoken to her yet. She'll be here soon.
Adverb of Place	Here, everywhere, near, nearby, down, away, backwards, upwards	 Is that your scarf there? I've lived here for about two years. I walked backwards towards the door. She turned her face upwards to the sun.
Adverb of Manner	So, slowly, badly, beautifully, delightfully, loudly	 The soldiers fought bravely. Is that so? She dresses beautifully. We waited anxiously by the phone.

ADVERBS:

- * Adverbs of time tells when an action happened.
- Adverb of place tells where the action happened.
- * Adverb of manner tells an action takes place.
