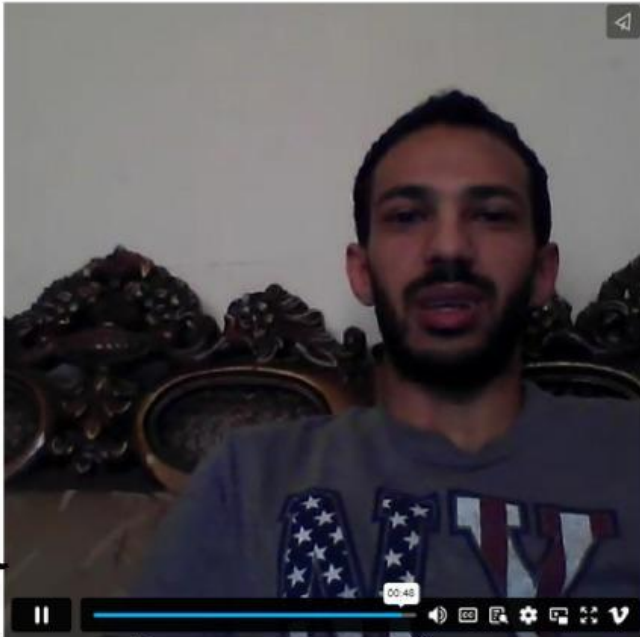
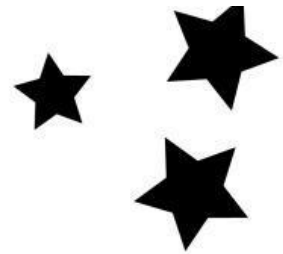




# OVERCOMING FEAR!

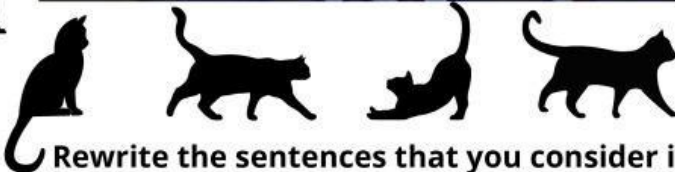


We are going to watch a video of a man from Egypt who tells us about a fear he overcame.
