It typically outlines the sequential steps required to complete the process effectively, using clear and concise language along with visual aids when necessary. Procedure texts are commonly found in instructional manuals, cookbooks, technical guides, and DIY tutorials. They aim to inform readers about the necessary actions to be taken in a logical and organized manner, facilitating the replication of the process with accuracy.

B. Design General Statements and Stages

Definition of General Statements and Stages of Procedure Text



The general statement or commonly referred to as the opening in the procedure text is the goal or end result that will be achieved if someone follows the steps in the procedure text. While the stages are the procedures that must be followed to achieve the right goal.

Steps in Designing General Statements and Steps in Procedure Texts

1. Determine the type or types of text to be designed, namely by determining the three categories of discussion contained in the procedure text, including texts that describe how something works such as how to use objects or other types of devices, texts that cover certain activities with rules and texts related to human nature or habits.
2. Determine the topic of the procedure text by choosing a topic that we are good at and that is useful for the reader.
3. Compose general statements and steps or stages
