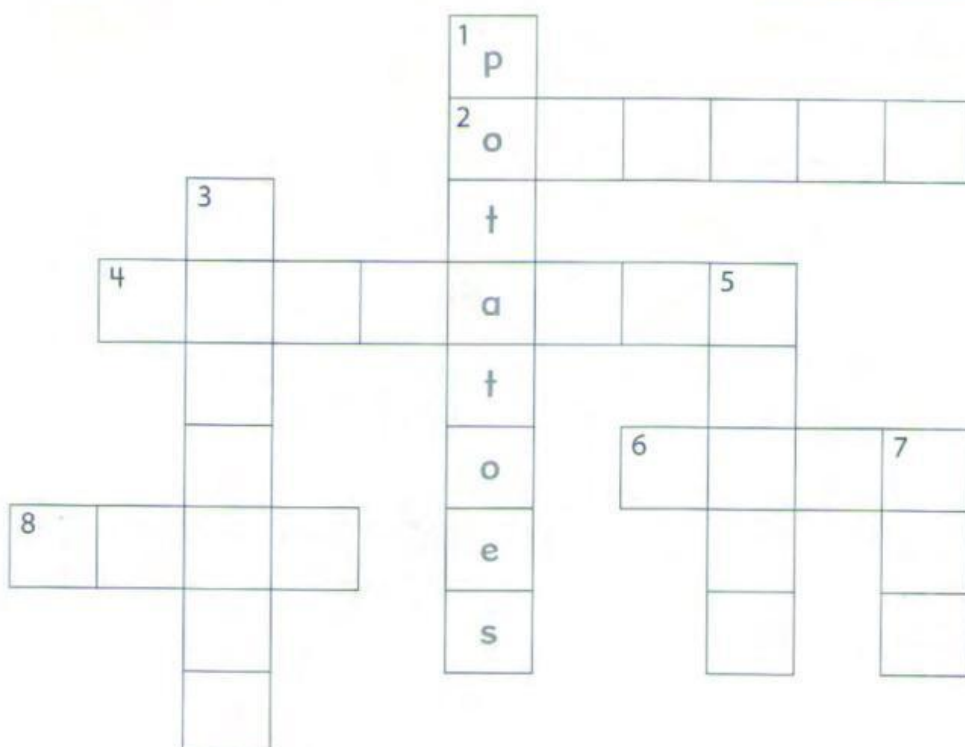

Luca doesn't understand, but he takes the bag. It is very heavy.



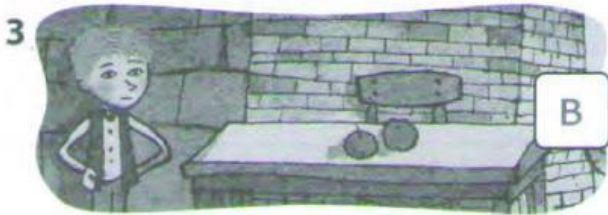
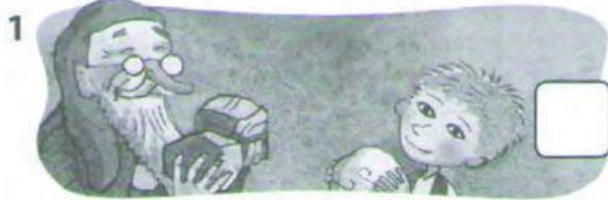
