




## WHAT ARE MODAL AUXILIARY VERBS

They are used along with a main verb to express ability, request, possibility, or suggestions





**For Example:**

- I **CAN** run very fast.
- **CAN** you help me with this math problem?
- He **CAN** go to the party if he passes all his classes.
- You **SHOULD** go to the doctor when you feel sick.

-  Subject + **MAV** + verb in base form+ complement

-  Subject + **MAV+ not** + verb in base form+ complement  
*They shouldn't play alone in the park.*
-  **MAV** + Subject + verb in base form + complement + T. E. + ?  
*Can I try that delicious cake?*
