They are used along with a main verb to express ability, request, possibility, or suggestions

### For Example:

- I CAN run very fast.
- CAN you help me with this math problem?
- He CAN go to the party if he passes all his classes.
- You SHOULD go to the doctor when you feel sick.

Subject + **MAV** + verb in base form + complement  
*We should be on time for the meeting*



Subject + **MAV+ not** + verb in base form + complement  
*They shouldn't play alone in the park.*



**MAV** + Subject + verb in base form + complement + T. E. + ?  
*Can I try that delicious cake?*
