The Muong ethnic group

The Muong ethnic group has the population of over one million people. They mainly live in the northern mountainous areas where have abundant land for harvesting wet rice. The Muong people have the same origin as the ancient Vietnamese. Therefore, their language belongs to the Viet-Muong language group.

In a Muong hamlet, stilt houses are located in the shade of big trees, huddle against the mountain, and look out on vast rice fields. A Muong house is designed to maximize convenient use and air ventilation to counter the warm, humid mountain climate.

The Muong's costumes are special. Men often wear a round-neck shirt which opens in the front and has two pockets. Their pants have large trouser legs. The Muong women wear a long, black dress and a white or brown shirt with a line of buttons in the front and long sleeves. They wind a white or indigo headscarf around their head.

The Muong have diverse folk arts including folk songs and poems, sorcerer's worshipping songs, tales, and riddle songs. The gong is the most popular musical instrument along with the flute, the two-string violin, the drum, and the panpipe.
