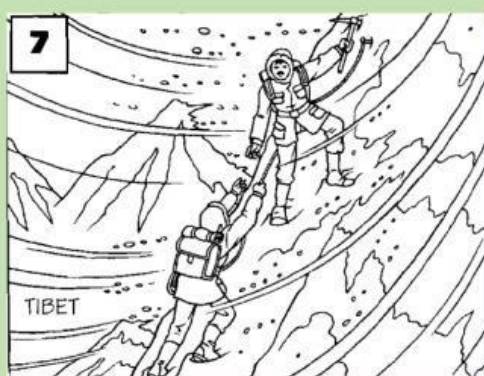
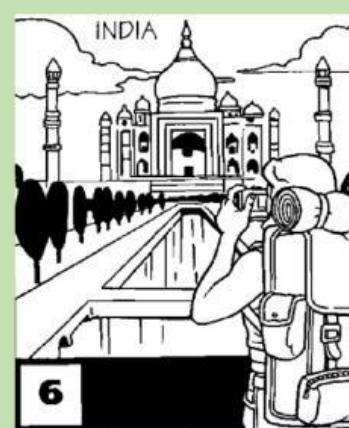


In June last year, eighteen-year-old Francis Thumber bought a “World traveller” ticket and set off in the adventure of a life time. Look at the pictures and tell the story.
