Cantonese	Neih hou (nah-hoh)	the main language spoken in all the world's Chinatowns	Southern China, Hong Kong, Macau
Catalan	Hola (o-la)	same word as in Spanish	Spain, Andorra, parts of France
Danish	Hallo (hah-low) hej (hi)	Great Danes are not from Denmark---they are from Germany	Denmark and some parts of Greenland

Hindi	Hindi: Namaste (nah-mas-tay)	Hindi is spoken by 366 million people across the world	India
