1) Chủ ngữ + **be/linking verbs** + bổ ngữ

People are clearly more curious about bad news than good. (Cam 5, T1, R)

The role of governments in environmental management is difficult but inescapable.
(Cam 3, T2, R)

Paid work is a valuable experience, important for learning and taking responsibility.
(Cam 3, T3, W)

Street signs, supermarket goods and even their own newspapers are all in English. (Cam 4, T2, R)

Traditional methods may prove economically valuable in the future. (Cam 3, T2, W)

2. Mẫu câu chỉ sự tồn tại

There + be + danh từ, được dùng để chỉ sự tồn tại của sự vật.

There is no such thing as an unbiased observation. (Cam 3, T1, R)

There was a decline in the number of Japanese tourists heading to Australia in 1989.

Ngoài ra there còn có thể kết hợp với 1 số linking verb như: come, emerge, exist, lie, live, occur, stand, be likely to be, happen to be, seem to be, turn out to be, used to be.

Now, however, there turned out to be more to the story. (Cam 5, T3, R)

As the wind freshened there came a sudden squall and the ship made a strange movement, listing to port.

In the 1950s and 1960s, there emerged an awareness in Western societies that resources for the provision of fossil fuel energy were finite and exhaustible. (Cam 4, T4, R)

There is expected to be a slight drop to 18% in 2030. (Cam 5, T1, W)

There are estimated to be more than 20,000 overseas domestic servants working in Britain.

3. Mẫu câu so sánh hơn

Cấu tạo cơ bản: tính từ / trạng từ so sánh hơn + than

Second-hand cigarette smoke does more harm to non-smokers than to smokers. (Cam 3, T1, R)

No activity affects more of the earth's surface than farming. (Cam 3, T2, R)

More food is now produced per head of the world's population than at any time in history. (Cam 5, T1, R)

The more effort put in and the wider the whole school involvement, the more substantial the results are likely to be. (Cam 6, T4, R)

Đôi khi trạng từ chỉ mức độ được đặt trước tính từ hay trạng từ so sánh nhằm nhấn mạnh.

Radio is far more portable than TV. (Cam 4, T1, R)

In every case, British spending is considerably higher than that of other countries. (Cam 3, T2, W)

It is a great deal easier to motivate employees in a growing organization than a declining one. (Cam 6, T3, R)

Their villages were little more than clusters of thatched huts. (Cam 3, T3, R)

By contrast, more women held undergraduate diplomas and marginally more women reached degree level. (Cam 4, T3, W)

4. Mẫu câu nhấn mạnh

Hình thức cơ bản của mẫu câu nhấn mạnh là “it is ... that”, “it is ... which” và “it is ... who”. Nếu đối tượng nhấn mạnh là vật, ta dùng hình thức 1 hoặc 2; nếu là người, ta dùng hình thức 1 hoặc 3. Đặt đối tượng cần nhấn mạnh vào giữa mẫu câu đó, những thành phần còn lại của mẫu câu gốc được đặt sau that, which hay who.

1) It is ... that ...

It is this type of exploitation **that** should be discouraged. (Cam 3, T3, W)

It is not necessarily these small languages **that** are about to disappear. (Cam 4, T2, R)

It is in the light of an expectation **that** some observations are held to be relevant and some irrelevant. (Cam 3, T1, R)

Of the six pollutants monitored by the WHO — carbon dioxide, nitrogen dioxide, ozone, sulphur dioxide, lead and particulate matter — **it is** this last category **that** is attracting the most attention from health researchers. (Cam 3, T4, R)

2) It is ... which ...

It was this lack of repair work **which** was directly responsible for the explosion. (Cam 4, T2, L)

World science is dominated today by a small number of languages, including Japanese, German and French, but **it is** English **which** is probably the most popular global language of science. (Cam 5, T2, R)

3) It is ... who ...

It was above all the French, followed closely by the Americans, **who** were the most passionate exporters of the new invention. (Cam 4, G, TA, R)

In terms of artistic development **it was** again the French and the Americans **who** took the lead. (Cam 4, G, TA, R)

4) It is not until ... that/which ...

It wasn't until the discovery of the reaction principle, **which** was the key to space travel and so represents one of the great milestones in the history of scientific thought, that rocket technology was able to develop. (Cam 3, T1, R)

It was not until the eighteenth century **that** Europe became seriously interested in the possibilities of using the rocket itself as a weapon of war and not just to propel other weapons. (Cam 3, T1, R)

5) ... is it that ...

Dùng trong mệnh đề chủ ngữ

What **is it that** makes them happy and fulfilled, while others seem doomed to founder in misery, dissatisfaction and dejection?

Dùng trong mệnh đề túc từ

Their aim is to find out why **it is that** some people's lives go so right.

A person needs to know who he or she is before being able to know what **it is that** makes him or her happy. (Cam 4, T2, W)

5. Cấu trúc đồng vị

Passive smoking, *the breathing in of the side-stream smoke from the burning of tobacco between puffs or of the smoke exhaled by a smoker*, also causes a serious health risk.

The formulation of scientific theory starts with the basic, raw evidence of the senses — *simple, unbiased, unprejudiced observation*. (Cam 3, T1, R)

The Waikato River, *the longest river in New Zealand*, flows through the center of the city, providing a picturesque and park-like setting of riverside walks and gardens. (Cam 3, G, TA, R)

In 1992, the United Nations Environmental Program and the World Health Organization (WHO) concluded that all of a sample of twenty megacities — *places likely to have more than ten million inhabitants in the year 2000* — already exceeded the level the WHO deems healthy in at least one major pollutant. Hamilton, *one of New Zealand's fastest growing cities*, is ideally located for a wide range of leisure and cultural activities. (Cam 3, G, TA, R)

6. Thành phần bổ sung

Thành phần bổ sung có chức năng cung cấp thêm thông tin cho câu, thường nằm sau dấu phẩy hoặc dấu gạch ngang. Mặc dù nằm trong câu nhưng sự tồn tại của thành phần bổ sung không ảnh hưởng đến kết cấu của cả câu. Thành phần bổ sung có thể là trạng từ, cụm giới từ, cụm động từ nguyên thể, cụm phân từ và cũng có thể là mệnh đề.

Thành phần bổ sung là trạng từ

This is done by a great number of ring-shaped air jets on the bottom of the craft. It “flies”, *therefore*, but it cannot fly higher.

Thành phần bổ sung là mệnh đề

Smoking, *it is believed*, is responsible for 30 per cent of all deaths from cancer and clearly represents the most important preventable cause of cancer in countries like the United States today. (Cam 3, T1, R)

“Hypotheses,” *said Medawar in 1964*, “are imaginative and inspirational in character.”

Democracy is, *among other things*, the ability to say “no” to the boss.

Robots are beginning to be seen, *although to a less degree*, in other industries as well.

We, *for our part*, are obsessed by the problem of how to render the basic facts of cohabitation simpler and more reasonable, in order that unhappy marriages may less frequently result.

Thành phần bổ sung là cụm động từ nguyên mẫu

It is said that the blood poison is, **so to speak**, a newer product from an improved formula.

Thành phần bổ sung là cụm phân từ

Robots, **becoming increasingly prevalent in factories, and industrial plants throughout the developed world**, are programmed and engineered to perform industrial tasks without human intervention.

For this reason there is no risk to the customer in the modern practice, **adopted by some banks**, of printing the customer's name on his cheques.

Thành phần bổ sung là mệnh đề trạng từ

It is important, **if one does not wish to inconvenience and to bore one's friends**, not to tell lies.

The biggest disparity and growing gap was in the area of spending on research and development, which, **while it decreased for the developing countries**, more than doubled for the industrialized countries. (Cam 3, T3, W)

The problem, **as I see it**, is that airport expansion and more flights will negatively affect the local economy. (Cam 3, G, TB, W)

Corporate crime is crime which, **as the name suggests**, is connected with companies, with business organizations. (Cam 4, T2, L)

Gloomy weather can cause depression, **but** sunshine appears to raise the spirits. (Cam 3, T3, R)

Volunteer work has its advantages, **but** it is not a true reflection of the working experience. (Cam 3, T3, W)

for *vì*

One can tell the difference almost at a glance **for** a spider always has eight legs and an insect never more than six.

That this has not happened may be the fault of the university, **for** at both Oxford and Cambridge the colleges tend to live in an era which is certainly not of the twentieth century, and upon a planet which bears little resemblance to the war-torn Earth.

while *mặc dù*

While these two events can be a forum for easing tensions and releasing patriotic emotions, they can also be a forum for creating tensions and disaster. (Cam 3, T1, W)

On the one hand modern imported goods may be used in an everyday setting, **while** on the other hand other traditional objects may still be required for ritually significant events. (Cam 3, T3, R)

whereas *trong khi, nhưng ngược lại*, cách dùng tương tự như **while**

In my opinion, men sometimes feel trapped by marriage, **whereas** women feel secure and content. (Cam 3, T3, S)

Spending on research and development actually fell in developing countries **whereas** in industrialized countries, this amount more than doubled. (Cam 3, T3, W)

and *và*

The gases trapped inside the boiling rock expand suddenly, the lava glows with heat, it begins to froth, **and** it explodes with tremendous force. (Cam 4, T3, R)

Many children may choose entrepreneurship because it allows them a degree of independence, is less exploitative than many forms of paid employment, **and** is flexible enough to allow them to participate in other activities such as education and domestic tasks. (Cam 4, T3, R)

so *vì vậy*

The geologist needs to know what rocks the drill has reached, **so** every so often a sample is obtained with a coring bit.

yet *tuy nhiên, vậy mà*

A bee's brain is the size of a grass seed, **yet** in this tiny brain are encoded some of the most complex and amazing behavioral patterns witnessed outside humankind. (Cam 4, G, TB, R)

not only ... but also *không những ... mà còn*

Not only did they break into his office and steal his books, **but** they **also** tore up his manuscripts.

Volcanoes have **not only** made the continents, they are **also** thought to have made the world's first stable atmosphere and provided all the water for the oceans, rivers and ice-caps. (Cam 4, T3, R)

or *hoặc*

You can ask me some questions, **or** you can read further in our excellent guide book.

(Cam 4, T1, L)

Most forms of environmental pollution either appear to have been exaggerated, **or** are transient. (Cam 5, T1, R)

Don't put anything plastic in the oven **or** it will probably start melting.

not ... but (rather) *không ... mà*

Typically, children do **not** end up on the streets due to a single cause, **but** to a combination of factors. (Cam 4, T3, R)

The incentive for the more aggressive use of rockets came **not** from within the European continent **but** from far-away India. (Cam 3, T1, R)

Perhaps the most fundamental step in developing a sense of number is **not** the ability to count, **but rather** to see that a number is really an abstract idea instead of a simple attachment to a group of particular objects. (Cam 6, T2, R)
