1. It is only in the study of man himself that the major social sciences have substituted the study of one local variation, that of Western civilization.

3. It was not until 1791 that the great French anatomist George Cuvier deduced that the animal was in fact a flying reptile, whose fourth finger supported a wing. (Cam 6, G, TB, R)

8. Although these molecules allow radiation at visible wave lengths where most of the energy of sunlight is concentrated, to pass through, they absorb some of the longer-wavelength, infrared emission radiated from the Earth's surface, radiation that would otherwise be transmitted back into space.

Well established among segments of the middle and upper classes by the mid-1800s, this new view of childhood spread throughout society in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries as reformers introduced child labor regulations and compulsory education laws, and predicted in part on the assumption that a child's emotional value made child labor taboo.

Should such an accident happen when the commanding officer is charging into a landing at high speed and trusting to his backing power to stop in time, merely to show himself to be a smart ship handler, the result may be a smashed bow or some worse accident caused not by an effort to perform some important service but merely by bravado.

However, when investment flows primarily in one direction, as it generally does from industrial to developing countries, the seemingly reciprocal source-based restrictions produce revenue sacrifices primarily by the state receiving most of the foreign investment and producing most of the income — namely, the developing country.
