

The weather was worse this year. Charlie's school had to close and his parents couldn't go shopping or go to work. It was too dangerous to drive their small car.


Examples

'We need toothpaste, too,' Dad said.


'That's OK,' said Charlie. 'We can get things like that on the internet! I know a good website!'




After breakfast Charlie's mum said, 'Come on, Charlie, we have to go shopping now.'
