


Q & A with (is, isn't, are, aren't)

(Look at the picture carefully. Then, click the correct answer. The first one had been done for you.)




Q: (Is / Isn't/ Are/ Aren't) Kelly **cleaning her house?**

A: (Yes / No), she (is / isn't / are / aren't).




Q: (Is / Isn't/ Are/ Aren't) Bob and Ann **playing tennis?**
