
He was a Lutheran Pastor who was an influential critic of Hitler and Nazism, executed in 1945. His theology and writings remain influential today.


He was a poet, writer and humanitarian. He was the first Indian to be awarded by Nobel prize for literature.

He was a Franciscan priest who encouraged devotion to Mary and was committed to praying for those hostile to the Church. In 1941, he was arrested for sheltering Jews and sent to Auschwitz. He volunteered to take place of a man condemned to death.
