1 This fish is very attractive. It can sell for hundreds or sometimes even thousands of dollars.



2 This elongated fish is a dangerous hunter with strong jaws and sharp teeth.



3 This fish is the largest animal on Earth. This is warm-blooded creature that nurses her young.



4 This is a deep-bodied fish. This fish is considered a prized edible fish worldwide.



5 Except in the Pacific Ocean, this fish is found everywhere. It likes overeating and killing more fish than it can eat.



6 This fish does not have scales, but some of its species are covered with overlapping armour plates.
