



HAVE YOU EVER?



We use this expression to ask about the most important past experiences of someone. There are two ways of replying to this question:

YES, I HAVE

NO, I HAVEN'T / NO, I HAVE NEVER.

Then, we can make more detailed questions using the past simple tense:

WHERE DID YOU PLAY SPORTS?

WHO DID YOU DO IT WITH?

WHEN DID YOU DO IT?

DID YOU ENJOY PLAYING IT?

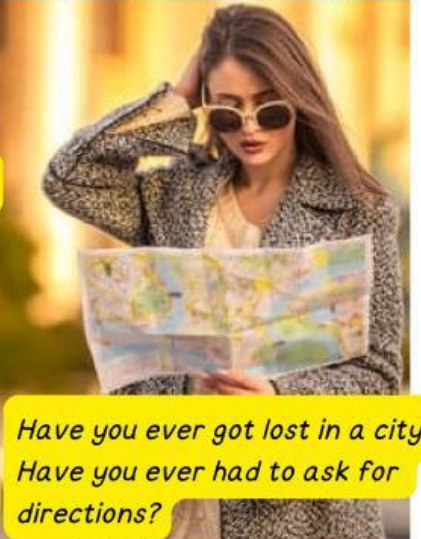

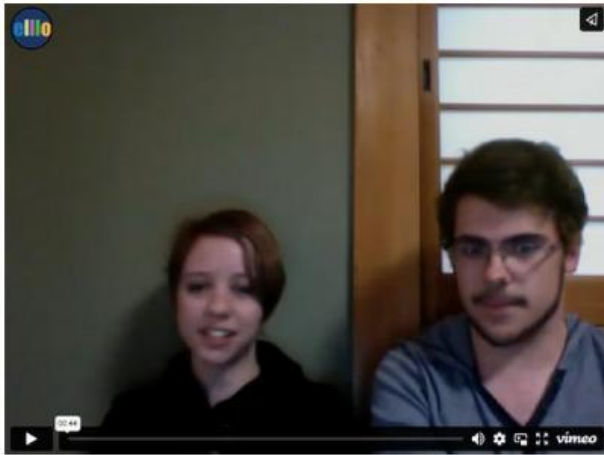

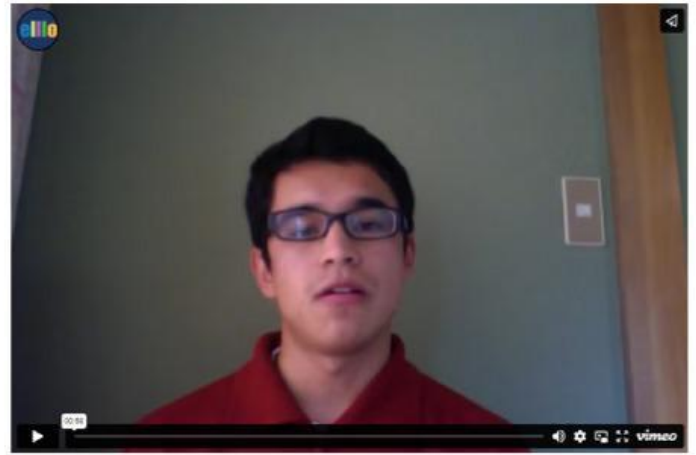
