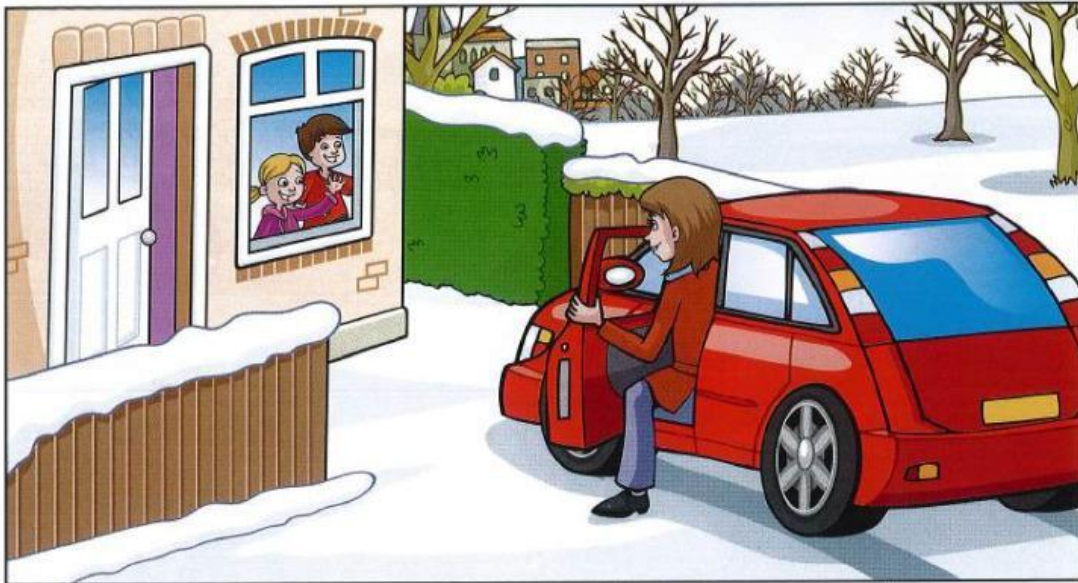

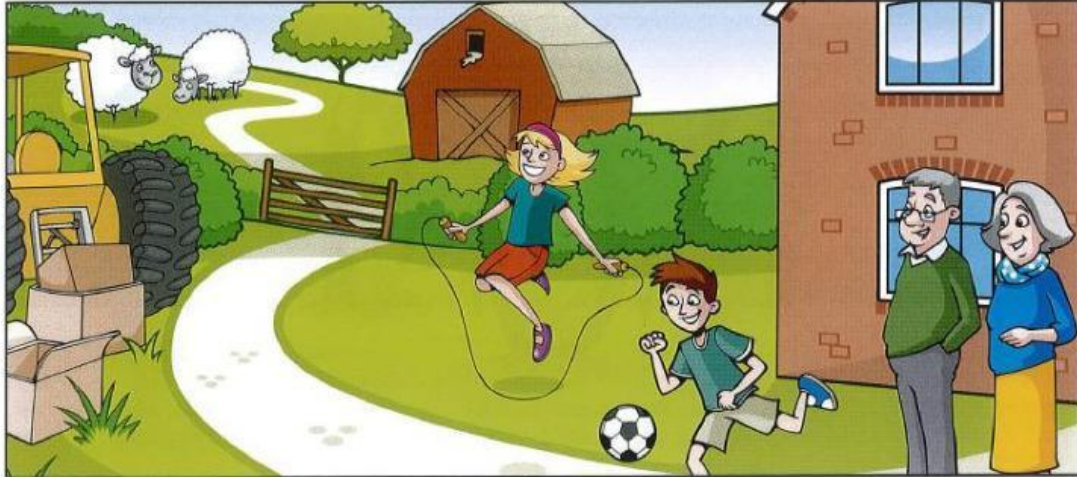

Last Saturday, when Grandma and Grandpa went into the house to make lunch, the children started to play a game. Julia hid in a place in the garden and Peter had to find her.

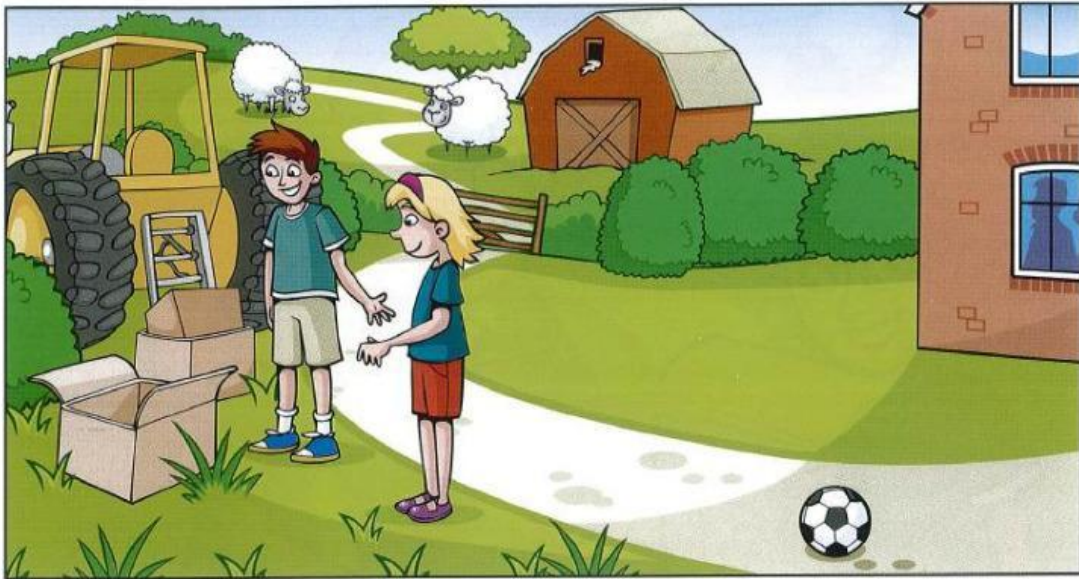
Examples
