<p>Ao dai is the Vietnamese national costume made of silk. Vietnamese wears a long silk dress over trousers. They wear Ao dai for weddings or important ceremonies. <input type="text"/></p>	<p>Bruneians wear traditional Malay costumes. Men wear <b>Baju Melayu</b>. Women wear brightly colored clothes. The dresses usually cover their body from head to toes. <input type="text"/></p>	<p>Myanmar's national dress is called <b>Longyi</b> which is a sarong to wear for both men and women.  *Sarong: a long piece of cloth that is worn wrapped around the waist. <input type="text"/></p>
<p>Lao women wear silk skirts, blouses and scarves. Lao men wear sarong or big large pants <input type="text"/></p>	<p>Men wear trousers and shirt called <b>Barong Tagalog</b> made from pineapple fabric. The women wear a long skirt, with puffy, butterfly-short sleeves blouse called <b>Balintawak</b>. <input type="text"/></p>	<p>The women's national costume is named the <b>Chakri</b>. It is made of Thai silk. The men's national costume is known as <b>Sue Phraratchatan</b>. <input type="text"/></p>

<p>Malaysian men wear <b>Baju Melayu</b>. It has a long sleeves shirt and long pants. Women wear <b>Baju Kurung</b>. It has an overcoat and <input type="text"/> a long skirt.</p>	<p>The traditional Cambodian <b>Sampot</b> is a long skirt with a fold in the front, but some sampot look more like trousers. It is worn with a simple <input type="text"/> shirt or blouse.</p>	<p>Indonesian women wear <b>Kebaya</b>. There is a long sleeve shirt front-buttoned shirt worn with a batik sarong. Men wear a batik shirt and trousers called <b>Teluk Beskap</b>. <input type="text"/></p>
<p>Singapore does not really have its own national costume because there are 4 different main races which are the Chinese, Malay, Indian and the Eurasians. Each race has its own costumes. For example, Malay women in Singapore wear <b>Kebaya</b>. <input type="text"/></p>
