<b>Cấu trúc</b>	<b>some + N</b> <sub>(không đếm được/dếm được)</sub> <i>Lưu ý: Thường dùng trong câu khẳng định</i>	<b>any + N</b> <sub>(không đếm được/dếm được)</sub> <i>Lưu ý: Thường dùng trong câu phủ định và câu nghi vấn</i>
<b>Ví dụ</b>	There are <b>some</b> cups in the kitchen. <i>(Có một vài chiếc chén ở trong bếp.)</i>	I do not have <b>any</b> books. <i>(Minh không có quyển sách nào cả.)</i> Do you have <b>any</b> coffee? <i>(Anh còn chút cafe nào không?)</i>

<b>Ý nghĩa</b>	Có một chút, đủ để làm gì	Rất ít, không đủ để làm gì (có khuynh hướng <b>phủ định</b> )
<b>Cấu trúc</b>	<b>a little + N</b> <sub>(không đếm được)</sub>	<b>little + N</b> <sub>(không đếm được)</sub>
<b>Ví dụ</b>	I have <b>a little</b> money, enough to buy a cake. <i>(Tôi có một ít tiền, đủ để mua một cái bánh.)</i>	I have <b>little</b> meat, not enough for you. <i>(Tôi có rất ít thịt, không đủ cho cậu.)</i>

	A FEW	FEW
<b>Ý nghĩa</b>	Có một chút, đủ để làm gì	Có rất ít, không đủ để làm gì (mang tính <b>phủ định</b> )
<b>Cấu trúc</b>	<b>a few + N</b> <sub>(đếm được số nhiều)</sub>	<b>few + N</b> <sub>(đếm được số nhiều)</sub>
<b>Ví dụ</b>	<b>A few</b> books are enough for me to read. <i>(Một vài cuốn sách là đủ để tôi đọc.)</i>	<b>Few</b> people pass this examination. <i>(Rất ít người vượt qua kì thi này.)</i>
