

Read the following text about universities.

Religion was **central** to the curriculum of early European universities. However, its role became less significant during the 19th century, and by the end of the 1800s, the German university model, based on more liberal values, had spread around the world. Universities concentrated on science in the 19th and 20th centuries and became increasingly **accessible to the masses**. In Britain, the move from the industrial revolution to modernity saw the arrival of new civic universities with an emphasis on science and engineering.

The funding and organization of universities vary widely between different countries around the world. In some countries, universities are predominantly funded by the state, while in others, funding may come from donors or from fees that students attending the university must pay.
