

COMPARING ANIMALS WITH ADJECTIVES



❖ We can make a difference between adjectives:

- short: 1 or 2 syllables.
- long: 3 or more syllables.

❖ The adjectives that finish with "y", we change this last letter into "i"

- Lazy---lazier than
- Happy---happier than

❖ If the adjective finishes in one vowel and one consonant we double the last letter

- big---bigger than

❖ Remember 2 SPECIAL ones:

- good---better
- bad--- worse

adjective + ER + than	more + adjective + than
Examples: • tall → taller than • short → shorter than • small → smaller than	Examples: • intelligent → more intelligent than • beautiful → more beautiful than • dangerous → more dangerous than
