No	Definition	Answer
1	Jazz developed from African American Folk Music, uses scale with flattened notes.	
2	Piano Jazz Style – right hand plays syncopated (jumpy melody), left hand plays vamp (boom-cha).	
3	Large piece for solo instrument accompanied by an Orchestra.	
4	Main song in an Opera.	
5	Upbeat Jazz music performed by a big band.	
6	Songs written with religious lyrics in a popular style could be sung by a choir.	
7	Originally from Jamaica combines native music with elements of rock and Soul. Strong accent on offbeat.	
8	Solo bagpipe music. Rhythmically very free.	
9	Music containing a Sitar and Tabla.	
10	Simple repeated phrases layered on top of each other.	
11	Large piece for full Orchestra.	
12	Rhyming lyrics that are spoken and performed in time to a beat. Popular in hip-hop.
