- ❖ Let's now prepare the 186th Home work project by creating HTML tags.
- ❖ 186 In the Home work project, prepare two Rows and add columns to those Rows and prepare the HTML tags related to the changes that should happen when you move the left mouse over the images added to those columns as follows.

For that, add a new div tag. Prepare a `<div class= "img-wrapper">` tag inside the tags that are prepared as `<div class= "item">`.

Highlighted here is the tag you need to add.
