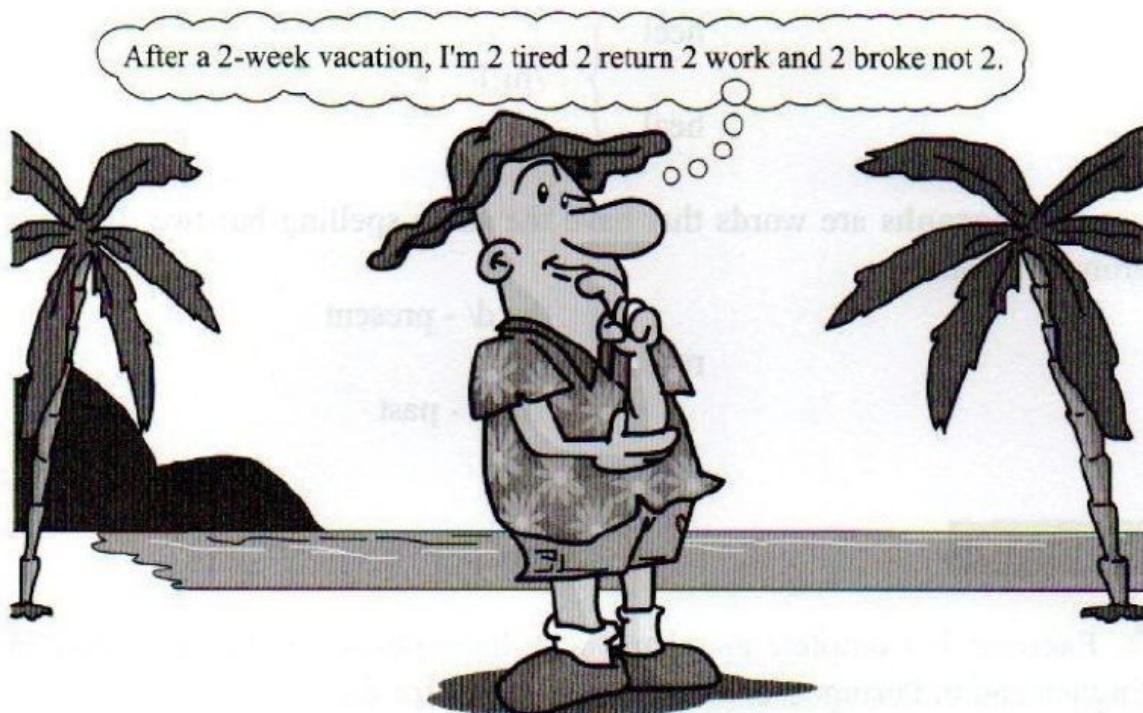

Homophones are words that have different spelling but sound the same:

heel }
heal } /hi:l/

Homographs are words that have the same spelling but two different pronunciations:

read } /ri:d/ - present
read } /red/ - past
