Cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) is a psychotherapeutic approach: a talking therapy. CBT aims to solve problems concerning **dysfunctional** emotions, behaviors, and cognitions through a goal-oriented, systematic procedure in the present.

The particular **therapeutic** techniques vary but commonly may include keeping a diary of significant events and associated feelings, thoughts, and behaviors; questioning and testing cognitions, assumptions, evaluations, and beliefs that might be unhelpful and unrealistic; gradually facing activities that may have been avoided, and trying out new ways of behaving and reacting. Relaxation, **mindfulness**, and distraction techniques are also commonly included.
