and ⁸ <u>there were</u> twelve ⁹ <u>peach-trees</u> that in the ¹⁰ <u>spring-</u>	8
<u>time broke out into</u> delicate blossoms of pink and pearl,	9
and in the ¹¹ <u>autumn</u> bore rich fruit. The birds ¹² <u>sat on</u> the	10
trees and sang ¹³ <u>so</u> sweetly that the children ¹⁴ <u>used to</u>	11

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One day the Giant came back. He ¹⁶ <u>had been to visit</u> his	15
friend the ¹⁷ <u>Cornish</u> ogre, and had stayed with him ¹⁸ <u>for</u>	16

all that he had to say, for ²⁰ <u>his</u> conversation was ²¹ <u>limited</u> ,	18
and he ²² <u>determined</u> to return to his ²³ <u>own</u> castle. When	19
