jewelry (n) /'dʒuːəlri/	decorations that people wear, such as rings and necklaces	Children shouldn't wear jewelry at school.

rock climbing (n) /'rɑːk klɑɪmɪŋ/	a kind of sport or an activity of climbing on a rock surface	Rock climbing is one of the most dangerous and adventurous sports.
board game (n) /'bɔːrd geɪm/	any games we can play on a board, often using dice	Monopoly is one of the most popular board games .

Grammar

Verbs (to express preference) + gerund

We can use a **gerund** (v-ing) after some verbs, such as **prefer**, **love**, **enjoy**, **like**, **don't** (really) **like** or **hate** to express our preference.

What does Peter **like doing** in his free time? - He **likes watching** TV.

Do you **love reading** comics? - I **don't like reading** comics, but I **enjoy reading** Conan detective series.


