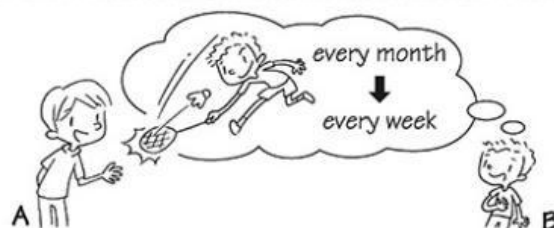


Future tense (3) be + going to

- A: What are you going to do next year?
 B: I'm going to do more sports.



We use **be + going to** to talk about things we have decided to do in the future.

future tense

Where **is Bob going to go** after school?
 He **is going to go** to the library.
 (Talking about the future)

present continuous tense

Where **is Bob going** now?
 He **is going** to the library.
 (Talking about the present)
