



# PAST SIMPLE or PAST PERFECT?

## SIMPLE PAST TENSE

We use Simple Past Tense to express action or actions started and finished at a specific time in the past.

**Examples :** I watched TV last night.

Henry painted the fence all day long yesterday.

## PAST PERFECT TENSE

We use Past Perfect Tense to express that an action or actions happened before something else happened.

**Examples :** I had eaten dinner before they came

Tilly had seen that film before it was on TV.
