



FUNCTION

The function of report text is to describe information about events that have occurred after thorough observation and analysis. The results of observation activities in a matter must be facts and what they are.

Step of Understanding Report Text

Identifying the main topic: Understanding the main subject discussed in the text.

Understanding factual information: Recognizing and understanding the facts presented about the subject.

Interpreting data: Understanding the significance of data or statistics that may be presented.

Understanding context: Understanding how information in the text relates to general knowledge or related issues.

Identifying purpose: Understanding why the information is presented and what the author is trying to achieve.
