3. Peter spent his childhood in Germany so he speaks German very well. (if)

4. You're not an efficient employee, so you weren't promoted. (have)

5. He was playing computer games all night so he is tired now. (will)

6. She didn't study medicine. That's why he isn't a rich woman now. (if)

7. I won't be able to get to work if George doesn't give me a lift. (Unless)

8. She will come to the conference if she doesn't have to make a speech.
(as long as)

9. I won't make a birthday cake unless you ask me.
(but only if)

10. Please come this way, and the chairman will see you in a moment.
(if)
