Blood in urine.

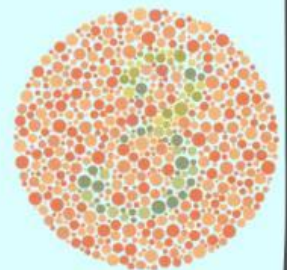


Disorder: _____
