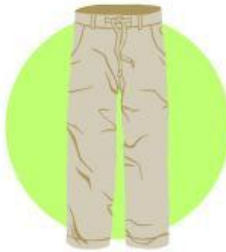

THE TRADITION OF CLOTHES:

Traditional clothes from various cultures often carry deep historical and cultural significance, and certain customs dictate how they must be worn. In Scotland, for instance, one must wear a kilt properly during formal events, ensuring that it is wrapped and pleated correctly. In Ancient Rome, citizens had to don the toga in a specific manner, as it was a symbol of status and citizenship.

In India, the sari must be draped elegantly, with each fold and pleat carefully arranged. Similarly, in Japan, one is required to wear the kimono in a particular way, with the left side always overlapping the right. Finally, in Mexico, the poncho should be worn in a way that allows for both functionality and style, respecting the garment's traditional roots.
