

Plastic Surgery

A surgical specialty called plastic surgery deals with the repair, reconstruction, or modification of the human body. It is classified into two categories: reconstructive surgery and cosmetic surgery.

Craniofacial surgery, hand surgery, microsurgery, and burn therapy fall under the category of reconstructive surgery. The surgery might be needed if you have birth defect like webbed fingers, cleft lip and palate. Similarly, if you have burns, scars that might prevent you from moving naturally or severe injuries such as cuts or tears over large area of skin, this kind of surgery will be a very helpful treatment.

On the other hand, cosmetic surgery aims to rebuild a bodily part or enhance its functionality. It is to treat medical conditions or improve beauty and involves changing certain body parts. The face, neck, breasts, stomach, arms, and legs are all possible areas for surgery.

Reconstructive and cosmetic surgery are performed by plastic surgeons. Cosmetic operations are carried out by a variety of surgeons. Plastic surgeons, dermatologists, otolaryngologists (ear, nose, and throat surgeons), among others, may do cosmetic surgery on you.

The healthcare provider you choose is crucial. Choosing a surgeon with specialised training and experience in the surgery you require will likely give better results for you. The best option is a surgeon who has passed a board exam. They must successfully complete testing and intensive training to prove they are knowledgeable about safety and quality procedures.

During your recovery, you could briefly feel "the blues" or depressed. Feelings of dissatisfaction and frustration may be increased by making hasty judgements about the outcomes of your surgery or delaying your return to normal activities. Realistic expectations should be set; progress, not perfection, should be the goal.
