The table provides insights into the proportion of students **which/ who** gave positive feedback for 5 different aspects of a university over a **ten-year/ ten-years** period from 2000 to 2010.

From an **overview/ overall** perspective, what stands out from the table is that with an **except/ exception** of building and teaching facilities, the **other/ others** aspects witnessed changes **on/ at** various paces over the period **on/ in** question. Another striking feature is that the figure for print resources was the highest as **opposed/ opposing** to **the other/ the others** at the beginning whereas that aspect, together with electronic resources, shared the dominant position at the end of the timeframe.

In detail, as for the aspect of electronic resources, the proportion of students **gave/ giving** good ratings for it exhibited a **double/ doubling, reached/ reaching** just under 90% in 2010. Similarly, with respect to teaching quality and print resources, both of their figures saw **rise/ rises** over the time although they grew **much/ more** less dramatically, with the former **to reach/ reaching 69%/ 88%** and the latter **to go up/ going up marginal/ marginally** to **69%/ 88%** at the end of the period.

**On contrast/ In contrast**, the number of students who were satisfied with the range of modules on offer declined **constant/ constantly** over the time, **falling down/ falling back** to just over a quarter.

**As regards/ As regard** building and teaching facilities, there was a stability at **rough/ roughly three-quarter/ three-quarters** over the period covered by the graph.
