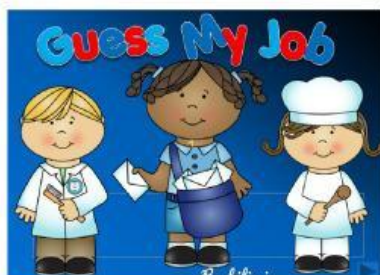

Exercise 1. Match the description with the correct job. (Write in the box the correct number)

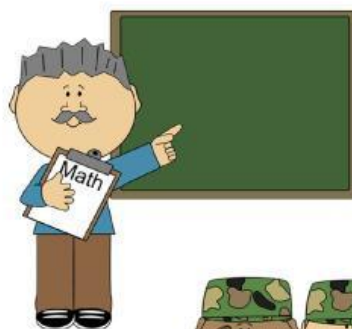
1. My job is difficult but rewarding. I work with children and adults. I teach the whole world to read and write and also teach them lots of interesting things.
