You can make comparisons using <b>comparative adjectives</b> .		
Matilda is <b>more serious</b> than Alice.      Bruce is <b>taller</b> than David.		
<b>Forming Comparative Adjectives</b>		
<b>Short adjectives:</b> (ending in -e)	large	larger
(ending in two consonants)	short	shorter
(one vowel + one consonant)	big	bigger
<b>Adjectives that end in -y:</b>	heavy	heavier
<b>Irregular adjectives:</b>	good	better
	bad	worse
<b>Adjectives with two or more syllables:</b>	interesting	<b>more interesting</b>
	serious	<b>more serious</b>
