

I. Main Idea and Details

J. Prediction

the narrator tells the story using the pronouns "You", "Your," and "Yours" to address a reader or listener directly

to make a connection from the book (story) to yourself



someone on the outside is looking in and telling the story as he/she sees it happen

tell what you think will happen in the future



the narrator is a character in the story (Words like I, me, or my are used)

to make a connection from the book (story) to something in the world
