

Subtract Fractions

Aim: to subtract fractions

Subtract the following fractions. You will need to convert the fractions so they all have the same denominator.

1. $\frac{2}{3} - \frac{1}{2} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$\frac{\hspace{1cm}}{6} - \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{6} = \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{6}$

2. $\frac{5}{8} - \frac{1}{2} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$\frac{\hspace{1cm}}{8} - \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{8} = \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{8}$

3. $\frac{3}{8} - \frac{1}{3} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$\frac{\hspace{1cm}}{24} - \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{24} = \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{24}$

4. $\frac{5}{6} - \frac{1}{4} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$\frac{\hspace{1cm}}{12} - \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{12} = \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{12}$

5. $\frac{7}{10} - \frac{2}{3} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$\frac{\hspace{1cm}}{30} - \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{30} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

6. $\frac{3}{4} - \frac{6}{10} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$\frac{\hspace{1cm}}{20} - \frac{\hspace{1cm}}{20} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
