c. What is the moral or lesson of the fable? Select the correct answer.

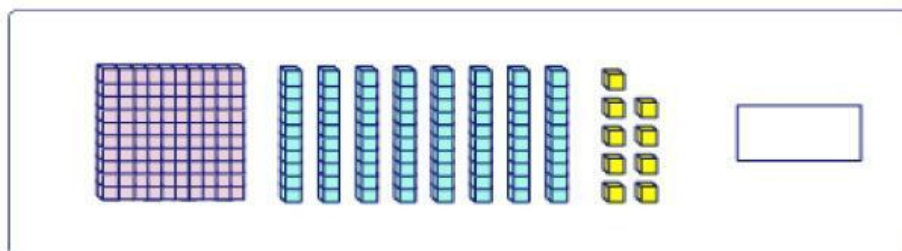
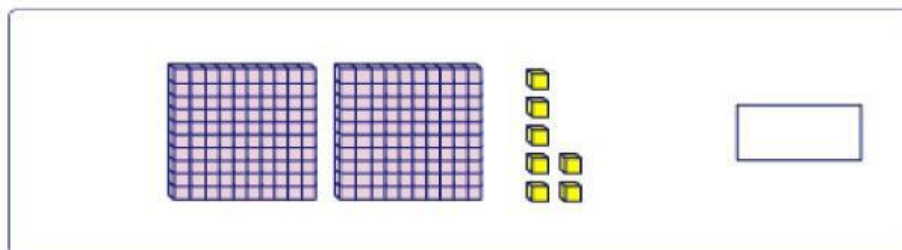
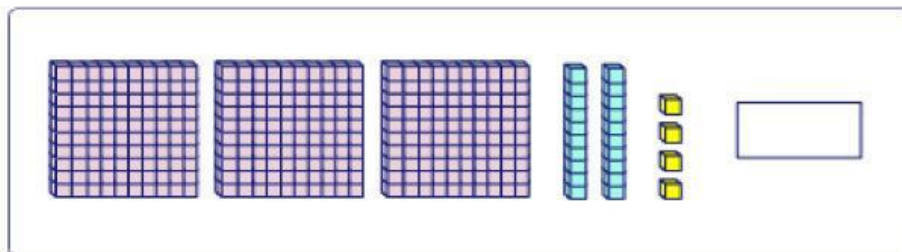
