

Present perfect tense (1)

have + past participle

I / We / You / They **have eaten** some sandwiches.I am not hungry now.

has + past participle

He / She / It **has drunk** some juice.He is not thirsty now.We use the **present perfect tense** when we talk about the present result of a past action.


