1. need / should / mustn't for advice: Cấu trúc lời khuyên với need / should / mustn't

NEED	SHOULD	MUSTN'T
- dùng need khi ta cần thực hiện một việc gì đó vì nó cần thiết S + need(s) + to + V-inf. - Ex: I need to run in order to keep fit.	- dùng should khi muốn khuyên ai đó nên làm gì S + should + V-inf. - Ex: You should go to bed before 10 p.m.	- dùng mustn't khi muốn khuyên ai đó không được làm gì S + mustn't + V-inf. - Ex: You mustn't start running without warming up your leg muscles.

2. First conditional sentence with SHOULD (Dạng đảo ngữ của câu điều kiện loại 1)

Mệnh đề IF (Nếu)	Nói về một điều kiện có thể xảy ra trong hiện tại hoặc tương lai
• Should + S + (not) V-inf,	
Mệnh đề chính (thì)	Nói về một kết quả có thể xảy ra trong hiện tại hoặc tương lai nếu điều kiện mệnh đề If xảy ra
• S + will / won't + V-inf.	

Ex: If he has a lot of money, he will help poor people.

=> **Should** he **have** a lot of money, he **will help** poor people. (Nếu anh ấy có nhiều tiền, anh ấy sẽ giúp người nghèo.)

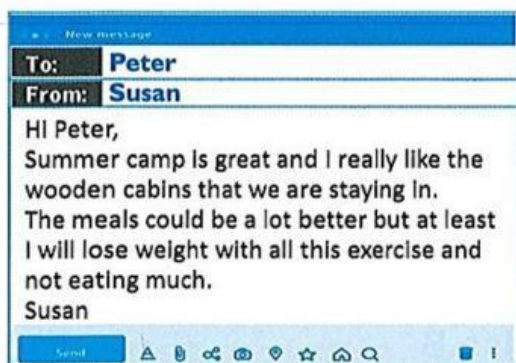

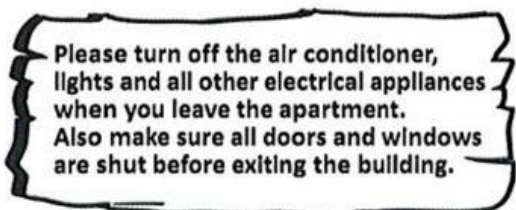
